Clinical Condition	Hallux Rigidus / 1st MTP joint arthritis
Eligibility	Pain/ swelling in the first metatarsophalangeal joint Limited range of motion at first metatarsophalangeal joint May be associated hallux valgus, metatarsalgia, lesser toe deformity

Differential Diagnosis	 Inflammatory arthropathy Hallux valgus Bursitis Sesamoiditis
Information required with referral	Detail history of the pain, deformity and swelling Any previous treatment eg Orthotics Any previous surgeries Associated medical conditions
Investigation required for the diagnosis	Full weight bearing foot x rays.
Pre-Referral management strategies (information required with referral)	 Orthotics/footwear modification Analgesics medicines
Referral Criteria	Continuous symptoms despite the non-operative management.
