Clinical Condition	Lesser toe deformities (Claw toe/ Hammer toe)
Eligibility	Lesser toe deformity +/- corns and callosities Often associated hallux valgus/ hallux rigidus Pain due to rubbing and corns Difficulty in wearing closed shoes

Differential Diagnosis	 Inflammatory arthropathy Neurological conditions eg Charcot Marie Tooth
Information required with referral	Detail history of the pain, deformity and swelling Functional limitations Any previous treatments eg Orthotics Any previous surgery Associated medical conditions Problems with footwear
Investigation required for the diagnosis	Full weight bearing foot x rays.
Pre-Referral management strategies (information required with referral)	 Appropriate footwear Orthotics/ spacer Analgesia
Referral Criteria	Continuous symptoms despite the non-operative management.
